



SUPER RUGBY AOTEAROA **HEALTH & SAFETY COVID-19 PLAN LEVEL 1**

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| PURPOSE | The purpose of this plan is to provide a formal, documented process for the management of the health risks associated with COVID-19 ensuring the health and safety of staff, contractors and guests attending Super Rugby Aotearoa at Eden Park. Normal EPT Health & Safety process and procedures still apply. |
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| | Note: This plan uses the health requirements stipulated by New Zealand Rugby to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at Super Rugby Aotearoa. Along with the mandatory controls required, Eden Park Trust has evaluated the ongoing community risk based on the guidance from the Ministry of Health. |
| SCOPE | This plan is applicable to all Eden Park staff, contractors, visitors, and guests. |
| RESPONSIBILITIES and AUTHORITY | All persons attending Eden Park must clearly understand and take an active role in meeting their responsibilities. EPT CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER EPT CEO is responsible for: • Developing and maintaining this plan in accordance with government advice relating to COVID-19 response. MANAGERS / SUPERVISORS EPT Managers / Supervisors are responsible for: • Developing, reviewing, and maintaining risk registers relevant to their areas related to COVID-19. • Implement relevant risk mitigation strategies to prevent potential spread of COVID-19. • Ensuring adequate resources are procured and deployed to prevent potential spread of COVID-19. • Ensuring all mandatory controls are implemented to prevent the spread of COVID-19. • Undertake reviews and provide feedback on the effectiveness of controls. • Consult and communicate with staff and contractors. |

| REQUIREMENTS | The COVID-19 operational controls are based on the most current information available from the Ministry of Health and the World Health Organisations. |
| | Range of measures that can be applied locally or nationally |
| | Border entry measures to minimise risk of importing COVID-19 cases. |
| | Intensive testing for COVID-19. |
| | Rapid contact tracing of any positive case. |
| | Self-isolation and quarantine required. |
| | Schools and workplaces open, and must operate safely. |
| | Physical distancing encouraged. |
| | No restrictions on gatherings. |
| | Stay home if you're sick, report flu-like symptoms. |
| | Wash and dry your hands, cough into your elbow, don't touch your face. |
| | No restrictions on domestic transport — avoid public transport or travel if you're sick. |
| RISK REGISTERS | A Risk Register will be maintained to ensure all relevant controls to prevent the spread of COVID-19 are identified, implemented, and reviewed. |

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| | The Risk Register will consider all risks associated with hosting a Super Rugby Aotearoa game at alert level 1. |
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| MANDATORY CONTROLS | EPT will implement mandatory access risk controls based on the physical layout, areas, activities, occupancy of areas under alert level 1. Controls will be prescribed in the Risk Register. |
| OCCUPANCY LEVELS | Under level 1 there is no restrictions occupancy levels in each space. There are no physical distancing requirements although physical distancing is still encouraged. Normal room occupancy levels under existing fire engineering designs for the various spaces will be maintained. |
| DEFINED SPACES | "Defined spaces" are important for the event sector, under COVID-19 as the provision is intended to allow multiple groups of 100 to be present at an event, where they are clearly separated. The reference to "defined spaces" is not applicable under Alert Level 1. |
| COVID-19 SIGNAGE | Signage displaying the conditions of entry shall be situated at each entrance outlining health and tracing requirements for entry and the implemented COVID-19 controls in place. Signage will be displayed providing details of key controls identified to prevent the spread of COVID-19 focusing on best practice hand hygiene and good cough etiquette. Signage will be displayed throughout BOH to focus on the ongoing provision of information and instruction to staff, contractors, and visitors. This will include the requirement for regular handwashing and sanitising. |
| CONTACT TRACING / ENTRY REQUIREMENTS | Eden Park will provide details to the Ministry of Health as required to proactively facilitate and participate contact tracing through: |



| | All staff, contractors, visitors, and guests visiting Eden Park as a condition of entry will be required to provide details for the purpose of contact tracing in the event of a request from the Ministry of Health. |
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| HEALTH SCREENING | Staff and contractors will be required to complete 2020 Investec Super Rugby Aotearoa COVID-19 Screening 48 hours prior to the games, then re-affirm the screening upon entry to the venue. |
| | Staff and contractors will be monitored upon entry to Eden Park for visual signs of illness and temperature monitoring conducted. |
| | Staff or contractors who display signs and symptoms of COVID- 19 will be restricted from entering Eden Park for a period of 14 days. |
| | Staff and contractors will be monitored by managers and supervisors for the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 while at work. |
| | Staff and contractors experiencing symptoms while at work will be immediately isolated and removed from the workplace to a designated isolation room for medical assistance. |
| | All incidents were a staff, contractor, visitor or guest is reported to have signs of COVID-19 including fevers, coughing or shortness of breath shall be reported in accordance with EPT Incident Management Procedures |
| | All incidents will be entered into the EPT Risk Manager Health & Safety software system. |
| HAND HYGENIE | Hand washing facilities will be available for use throughout Eden Park, e.g. in rest rooms, kitchens, and other areas where facilities are available. |
| | Hand wash facilities will be supported by hand sanitiser stations located around the stadium. |
| PHYSICAL DISTANCING | Whilst there is no requirement under COVID-19 Alert Level 1 physical distancing is still encouraged. |
| | All staff and contractors whilst working will be requested to maintain a physical distance of 1 metre as far as reasonably practical. |
| | Areas where there is a high potential for waiting and queuing to occur will have MOH signage to promote adequate physical distancing in place. |
| | In the event of frequent or excessive queuing, Eden Park will implement local queuing management to enforce physical distancing requirements. |
| CLEANING | Pre-event, during and post event cleaning of the venue will be completed in line with the New Zealand Rugby - Guidelines and |

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| | recommended operating procedures - Return to training and competition following removal or reduction of COVID19 Government restrictions |
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| | Cleaning practices will be increased during the event to prevent the spread of COVID-19, |
| | With special attention paid to high touch surfaces and communal areas using alcohol-based sanitiser or industrial cleaning agents focusing on: |
| | o Door handles |
| | o Door push plates |
| | o Handrails |
| | o Lift buttons |
| | o Toilets |
| | Any other surface identified as being touched by people (high frequency) |
| | (Note: All other surfaces will be regularly cleaned as per normal operating procedures) |
| AWARENESS | All staff and contractors will be made aware of the following: |
| | The signs and symptoms of COVID-19. |
| | Reporting requirement of illness. |
| | Restricting of attending work when exhibiting signs and symptoms of COVID-19. |
| | Sanitising and cleaning protocols. |
| | Hand hygiene and coughing etiquette. |
| | Visitor and guest requirements in relation to COVID-19 |
| HEALTH, SAFETY & SECURITY | Normal EPT Health, Safety and Security procedures and processes will be followed. This includes: |
| | Pre-Event, and Event Safety & Security Inspections completed |
| | Fire exit doors operational |
| | Fire & smoke doors / shutters closed / operational Emergency egress routes clear |
| | Emergency wayfinding signage illuminated / visible |
| | Firefighting equipment access / compliant Fire detection system operational |
| | Fire panels / risers / hydrants access |
| | F&B unit appliances operational / compliant (gas/ electrical / |
| | emergency shut offs) Mobile vending units operational / compliant (gas/ electrical / electrical supply leads / fire-fighting equipment / naked flames / combustible materials) |

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| Sponsors / hirers activations set up meet EPT mobile unit / activation safety requirements Hazardous substances secure (not accessible) Temporary structures safety & compliance signed off (camera platforms) External area checks safety & security (gardens / car parks / bus hub / surrounding streets) Lounge and suite safety checks (egress / occupancy requirements / equipment safety / electrical cable leads) Toilet facilities safety & security (suspicious items) |
