

COVID-19 PLAN - SUPER RUGBY AOTEAROA

HEALTH & SAFETY

Signage

- Signage displaying COVID-19 conditions of entry shall be situated at each entrance outlining health and tracing requirements for entry.
- QR codes displayed at entry gates and throughout the stadium.
- COVID-19 signage - contact trace QR code scan, hand hygiene and good cough etiquette displayed throughout public areas.
- COVID-19 signage - contact trace QR code scan, hand hygiene and good cough etiquette displayed at mobile vending units.
- COVID-19 signage - displayed throughout BOH to focus on the on-going provision of information and instruction to staff, contractors, and visitors including the requirement for regular handwashing and sanitising.
- QR code scan in / hand wash signage displayed on big screen ribbon, IPTV throughout stadium, Gate A plaza Super Screen

Contact Tracing

- Ministry of Health QR codes displayed at entry gates and throughout stadium – (onus on patrons to self-scan)
- Staff details available through service providers registers (as required)

Health Monitoring

- Staff and contractors will be required to complete 2020 Investec Super Rugby Aotearoa COVID-19 Screening 48 hours prior to the games, then re-affirm the screening upon entry to the venue.
- Staff and contractors will be monitored upon entry to Eden Park for visual signs of illness and temperature monitoring conducted.
- Staff or contractors who display signs and symptoms of COVID-19 will be restricted from entering Eden Park for a period of 14 days.
- Staff and contractors will be monitored by managers and supervisors for the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 while at work.
- Staff and contractors experiencing symptoms while at work will be immediately isolated and removed from the workplace to a designated isolation room for medical assistance.

Hand Hygiene

- 50 Hand sanitiser stations have been installed in key locations around the stadium both in public and BOH areas.

Cleaning

- Pre-event, during and post event cleaning of the venue will be completed in line with the New Zealand Rugby - Guidelines and recommended operating procedures - Return to training and competition
- Cleaning practices increased during the event with special attention paid to high touch surfaces and communal areas using alcohol-based sanitiser or industrial cleaning agents focusing on:
 - Door handles
 - Door push plates
 - Handrails
 - Lift buttons
 - Toilets
 - Any other surface identified as being touched by people (high frequency)
