



Model Work Health and Safety (WHS) laws require a Person Conducting a Business or Undertaking (PCBU) to –

- Take care of the health, safety and welfare of your workers, including yourself and other staff, contractors and volunteers, and others (clients, customers and visitors) as your workplace
- PCBUs have a duty to provide and maintain, so far as is reasonably practicable, a working environment that is safe and without risks to the health.



DUTIES UNDER WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY LAWS

This includes preventing, and where prevention is not possible, reducing risks to health or safety associated with potential exposure to COVID-19.



To meet **obligations**, PCBUs (inc business owners) need to adopt <u>proactive</u> <u>risk management strategies</u> in minimising the potential for contracting COVID-19 in the workplace context.

It is important that you:

- Actively consider the context of your business the workplace, the work carried out, your workers and visitors who attend the workplace
- Do what you reasonably can to eliminate or minimise the risk of the people at your workplace contracting COVID-19
